

#### CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

Your Group continues to perform well. Turnover increased to K£3,282,377 as compared to Κ£2,502,389 in the previous year. Pre-tax profits increased to K£545,699 as compared to K£426,650 in the previous year, an increase of almost 28%. Taxation amounted to K£233,087 as compared to K£231,933 in the previous year, leaving an attributable profit of K£312,612 as compared to K£194,717 the previous year, an increase of over 60%. Individual Company's performance is summarized below:-

EXPRESS KENYA LIMITED. NAIROBI

All trading divisions of this company namely Seafreight, Airfreight, Transport, Warehouse, Travel, Touring and American Express performed well during the year.

**EXPRESS MOMBASA LIMITED** 

This company did extremely well during the year and contributed substantially to the Group's profits. The company is expanding its services in the fields of Warehousing and Containerisation.

**CONTAINER SERVICES LIMITED** 

Container business continues to increase in Nairobi particularly due to increased activities at the Inland Container Depot at Embakasi.

**OCEANUS LIMITED** 

This company continues to be retained for shipping purposes.

AIRPORTER LIMITED

During the year your Group acquired this new company which is used for Airport Transfers.

**EUROPCAR DIVISION** 

Again during the year your Group acquired the Europear Franchise. This is one of the major Car Hire companies in the world. We started our operation in July 1988 with a fleet of all ranges of cars. We now have offices at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport Nairobi and also in Bruce House Standard Street, Nairobi. More offices are to be opened in the other major towns in the country. In due course it will be one of the largest Car Hire firms in the country.

**EXPRESS TRAVEL CENTRE** 

During the year the Travel Related Services moved from Consolidated House to a more spacious and prestigious location in Bruce House, Standard Street, Nairobi. Travel, Tours, American Express and Europear are now based in this new location.

KITUI ROAD PREMISES

Again during the year your Company purchased Kitui Road premises where the operations of bonded warehouse and packing are situated.

DIRECTORATE

Mr. Kiriinya Mwendia joined the Board as the Financial Director during the year while Mr. C.J. Lance was appointed alternate Director to Mr. M.K. Too. Mr. J.J. Austen-Brown resigned from the Board during the year. I wish to take this opportunity to thank my fellow directors for their cooperation and assistance during the year.

MANAGEMENT

I wish also to thank the entire Management of the Group for their continued good work. They continue to provide excellent services to our customers.

I am pleased to announce that the Board of Directors have recommended payment of a dividend at the rate of 36% per share as compared to 25% paid in the previous year on the paid up share capital of KShs.6,000,000/-.

The results of the first quarter are well within budget, however it is too early to predict the performance of the Group for the rest of the Financial Year.







Mr. Ruben used his War Gratuity and savings to buy a number of mules and carts with which he set up what was to be called Express Transport Company for many vears.

Over the years, Express Transport Company expanded and later diversified its activities to include many other services. The most notable, in the early twenties, was when the company was appointed to handle travel services for Wilson Airways. "Express" also expanded in the field of clearing and forwarding to become one of the leading agents in East Africa. It has offices in both Nairobi and Mombasa.

Express Kenya in its present form is a public company with more than 1400 shareholders. It is quoted on the Nairobi Stock Exchange and is the only one of its kind in the service industry.









This Division provides transport services of all types with particular reference to out-of-gauge loads. The Division has a large fleet of vehicles ranging from light vans to vehicles capable of carrying up to 80 tons.




## PROFIT/(LOSS) AFTER TAX IN K£'000



#### 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### (a) Accounting convention

The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention adjusted by the revaluation of certain fixed assets.

#### (b) Depreciation and amortisation


